University Campus Suffolk is a partnership between the Universities of East Anglia and Essex offering a range of courses at venues across the region. With the main campus in Ipswich, UCS will be offering courses at centres in Bury St Edmunds, Great Yarmouth, Lowestoft and Otley. Other towns across the county will utilise existing buildings such as libraries, council offices and some major stores to act as smaller learning points.

University Campus Suffolk will be welcoming its first students in September 2007.

UCS Bury St Edmunds

The Bury St Edmunds Centre is located at West Suffolk College and offers a range of higher education courses for the local community and beyond. 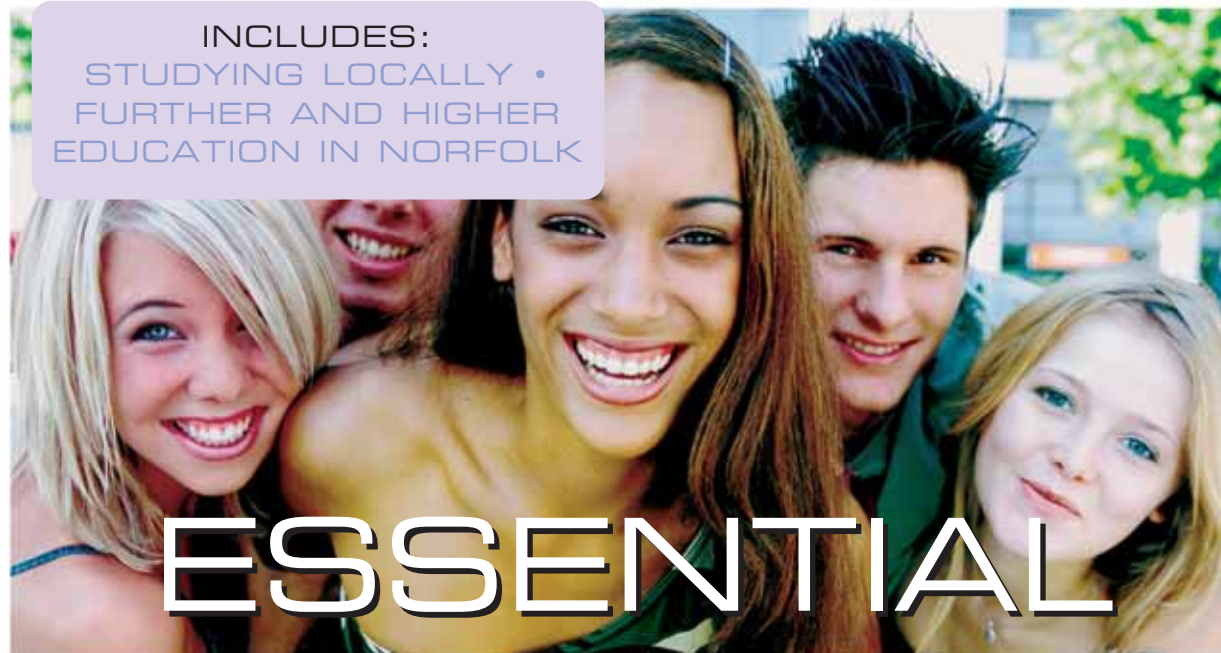

STUDYING LOCALLY

Courses and qualifications are:

Academic – you study a subject for its own sake. Most GCSEs or A levels are academic.

Vocational – you learn about a range of jobs or an industry. BTEC First & National Diplomas and Vocational A Levels are vocational courses.

Occupational – train for a job. National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs) are the main occupational qualification.

Courses are also divided into levels, running from 1 through to 8. You can study at all levels at a university or college in Norfolk.

Level	Examples of courses
1	BTEC Introductory Diplomas, GCSEs grades D to G, NVQ1
2	GCSEs A to C, BTEC First Diplomas, NVQ 2
3	A/AS Levels, Vocational A Levels, BTEC National Diplomas, NVQ 3
4	Certificates of Higher Education
5	HNDs, Foundation Degrees, Diplomas of Higher Education
6	Degrees
7	Masters
8	Doctorates



WHO DOES WHAT AT LEVEL 2 & 3?



To see all the Level 1, 2 and 3 courses in Norfolk colleges and sixth forms, look in Your Next Move Prospectus from Connexions Norfolk. It should be available in your school or college. If you have difficulty getting hold of a copy, please ring your local Connexions Centre and ask for one.

Pages 6 to 29 of Your Next Move Prospectus include tables and lists of who offers what in Norfolk sixth forms and colleges. (The key to the course tables is under the bookmark on the cover.) Your Next Move includes contact details for all the colleges and sixth forms in Norfolk – 'phone numbers, emails and websites.

If you are looking to do a vocational course at college you might also want to think about Apprenticeships in Norfolk. Lists of apprenticeships are on pages 34 to 41 of Your Next Move Prospectus and some contact details are on pages 42 to 43.
