A range of activities aimed at specific groups of young people; those clearly interested in apprenticeships and those have identified needs, vulnerabilities or risks. Young people will be referred to these activities. Supporting Gatsby benchmarks and PAL requirements.. Parent/carer activities and teacher CPD also available.

## Individualised

A bespoke plan tailored to a young person, shaped around their unique circumstances, strengths and goals. Young people will be referred to this level of support.
